Stevie Ray Vaughn

Placed by the Stevie Ray Vaughan Memorial Foundation in 1993, the cast bronze statue of the famed guitarist created by artist Ralph Helmick stands on the south shore of the Trail just west of Vic Mathias (Auditorium) Shores. Vaughn was a legend in Austin and frequently played at clubs like Antone's and Continental Club. This statue is one of 8 permanent installations on the Trail that pay tribute to influential musicians. The other 7 are found along the Legends of Tejano Music Trail that stretches from the Mexican American Cultural Center to the north end of Longhorn Dam.
