Boardwalk

In 2014, the completion of the boardwalk marked a significant milestone for the Trail. This addition allowed walkers, bicyclists, and runners to enjoy a scenic lakefront route, safely separated from the increasingly busy sidewalks and roadways. Closing a 1.1-mile gap in the 10-mile loop around Lady Bird Lake, the boardwalk ensured continuous and ADA-compliant access for pedestrians and cyclists. This project not only enhanced public access to the lake and parkland but also provided a safe, alternative mode of transportation, reducing the reliance on cars and improving the city's transportation and recreation network.
